**11<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**Orientation Programme for the Faculty on “Effective Teaching methods in Higher Education”**

IQAC of St. Anne's Degree College for Women in its primary effort organized an Orientation Programme for all the Faculty members on “**Effective Teaching methods In Higher Education on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2018.** The main objective of choosing this topic was that the Quality Education has a great influence on student learning which a primary goal of higher educational institutions.
